“Cyber-Empowerment”, one of NJ CAP’s newest programs, is offering a student session which delves into the cyber world of today’s youth. The workshops explore how some electronic communications are opportunities for bullying, bias crimes and violence among students. This workshop was created in collaboration with Rowan University Education Students. This Cyber-Empowerment Session provides 6th-8th grade students with an understanding of cyber activity while teaching them realistic ways to help keep their own rights and guard the rights of others.

Cost:

Schools applying for CAP funding must provide a minimum of **50%** of the total cost of implementation.

If your district is eligible for urban aide funding or can document financial need and other related factors, this provision may be waived. Applications will not be accepted without waiver documentation when requesting the 50% exemption. Exceptions to this provision must be documented and approved by the State CAP Office/EIRC.

Depending on availability of funds, the school may be responsible for additional funding.
