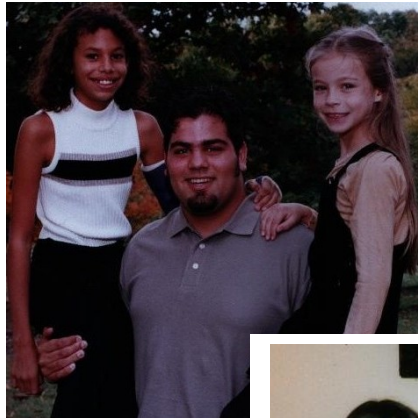

Since 1984, the New Jersey Child Assault Prevention (CAP) project has been one of our state's most successful and well respected primary prevention programs. More than 2 1/2 million children and 300,000 parents and teachers have participated in CAP's empowering workshops.

In addition to providing much-needed prevention strategies to our communities, NJ CAP also sponsors an award ceremony to honor those who have demonstrated, through their lives, a dedication to the prevention of bullying and/or child abuse and neglect. More than 400 people attend the ceremony. Qualifying Criteria: The NJ CAP Advisory Board will use one or more of the following criteria to determine if your nominee qualifies for consideration for this statewide award.

- A. Has shown support of the CAP project programmatically, philosophically, legislatively or financially.
- B. Has lobbied for or introduced legislation which advocates for children and quality prevention programming.
- C. Has taken action which has reduced bullying in schools or neighborhood or has prevented child abuse situations from occurring.
- D. Has demonstrated a pro-active role in advocating for child abuse victims.
- E. Has promoted bullying and/or child abuse prevention as a primary focus in his/her life.
- F. Has demonstrated a positive role in the prevention of bullying and/or child abuse and neglect in the community.

Instructions: In order for the NJ CAP Advisory Board to select recipients for this statewide award they need as much personal and professional information as possible. On a separate page, please submit a **detailed narrative** for each of the questions listed below. Keep in mind that this award is specifically designed to honor those who are or have been involved, either personally or professionally, in the prevention, intervention or treatment of bullying and/or child abuse and neglect.

1. What has the nominee done in the field of bullying and/or child abuse prevention?
List specific accomplishments, programs, activities, etc.
2. How many years has the nominee been involved in child abuse and/or bullying prevention or in the specific activity for which he/she is being nominated?
3. How have individuals/communities benefited from the nominee's efforts?
4. What makes this nominee different from others who might be doing the same job, participating in similar activities or accepting similar responsibilities?
5. Why do you feel this nominee is deserving of a statewide child abuse prevention award?
